Communication with Parents:

- We will work with parents to develop a school-parent compact that outlines the commitments of teachers, parents, and students to foster academic success for each child. We will provide parents with a copy of this compact via First Day Folders, will post a copy to the school website.
- We will provide parents an explanation of the curriculum used at Waverly Belmont, the forms of academic assessment used to measure student progress and the proficiency levels that students are expected to meet.
- We will strive to communicate clearly and effectively with parents by a variety of communication strategies including, but not limited to, weekly newsletters, information & updates emails, call-out announcement system, school website, progress reports, report cards, by mail, phone, and emails.
- Parents will have access to the parent portal, which allows parents to access their student's grades, attendance and assignments. Through this system, the parents can set triggers to receive notifications about grades and attendance.

Meeting with Parents:

- We will offer parent meetings, monthly PTO meetings and parent/teacher conferences, at various times.
- We will offer Parent/Teacher conferences throughout the year so that parents can meet with their students' teachers and work together to help the student achieve academic success. A parent can request a meeting with the student's teacher(s) at any point in the school year.
- We will provide opportunities for regular meetings with parents to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to the education of their student.
- The Waverly Belmont Elementary School administration team maintains an "open door" policy with parents for phone calls, emails and conferences.

Parent Participation:

- We will collaborate with parents on the School Improvement Plan/School Budget. Parents are an integral
